Freemasons' Hall is situated in Great Queen Street, London WC2B 5AZ. The nearest underground stations are Holborn and Covent Garden.

CAR PARKING

The nearest car park is an NCP facility located in Parker Street. If you travel by car, you will be liable for the Congestion Charge for driving in London and Ultra Low Emissions Zone if your vehicle isn't exempt.

ON ARRIVAL

There will be signs to direct you to the appropriate signing-in points and changing rooms as follows
