We have reported in the past on the great work being done by the West London Masonic Centre during the pandemic. Rohit Pattni brings us up to date on the latest:

Christmas 2020: we carried on preparing the cooked meals for distribution to the local

community via the organisations that we have been working with. By the end of December we had cooked just under 13,000 meals. In addition we prepared basic food packages for 425 families. Each package consisted of fresh fruits, vegetables, rice, pasta, biscuits, tinned foods, bread and milk. This was distributed again by the local organisations that we have been working with. They added items to make up the packages relevant to each family. These packages were put together with a view of supporting a family of four for a week.... READ MORE

This January I participated in fundraising for Prostate Cancer UK....The aim was to run at



least 26.2 miles in the month – and for a beginner like me that was quite a challenge! However, with massive support from friends, family and Freemasons on various Social Media channels I completed this – I actually ran 37.1 miles, and the last 2 was with my 10 year old son doing his first "long-distance" run. In total (excluding Gift Aid) I raised £2,404 which was far in excess of anything I thought I could raise – and I'd like to thank all those within the Province who spared their hard earned money in these challenging times to support me. It is quite overwhelming to see so much generosity.



Following the Provincial Quiz, where we were able to raise £800 for UNHCR, the Provincial Grand Master received a letter of thanks from the UK Head of Fundraising which said "Your support will not only protect families like Amira's [see video link above] – it will also tell them something very important. It will tell them that they have not been forgotten and that there are compassionate people in the world who are prepared to act on their behalf. Thank you again for standing with refugee families and I look forward to letting you know more about UNHCR and the incredible impact of your support."


