By the end of this week, 5 Mark Lodges will have met at Mark Masons' Hall and - judging by the social media posts - the brethren are delighted to be back in each other's company.



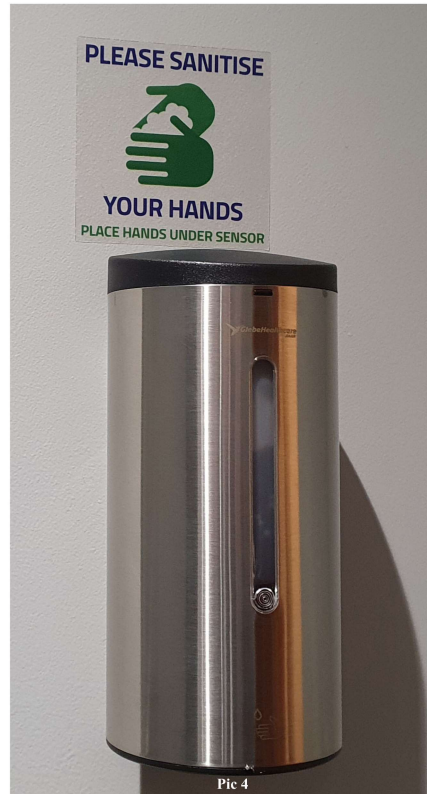

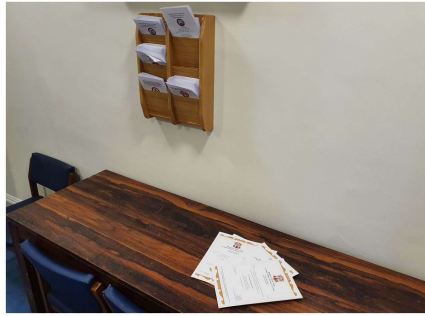

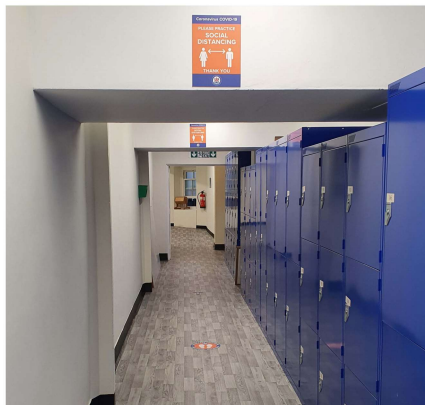

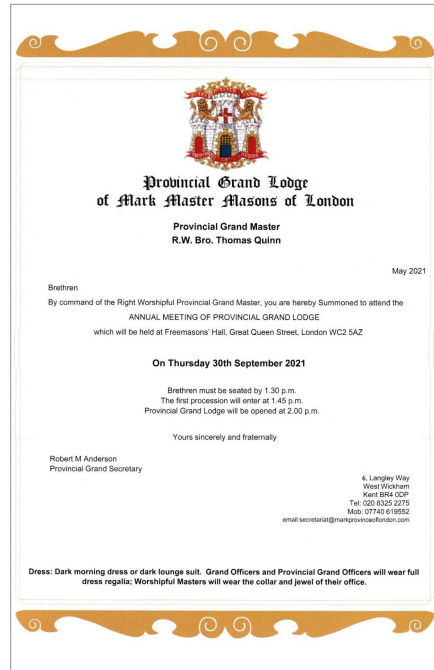

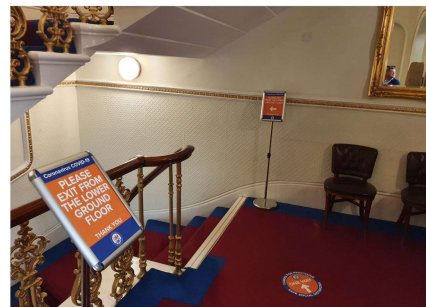

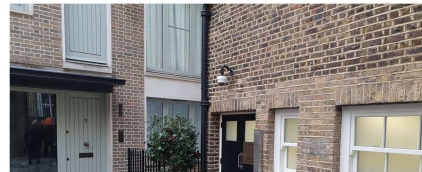
